

For there has never been an African-American appointed or elected to the Town Board of Trenton, North Carolina. Nor, are there any African-Americans elected or appointed to the Board of County Commissioners of Jones County. The Town of Trenton and the County of Jones have failed to promote eligible applicants to establish service in communities that are not currently served.
