In a historic step for the protection of clean water, EPA and the Army signed the Clean Water Rule on May 27, 2015, to protect the streams and wetlands that form the foundation of the nation's water resources from pollution and degradation.

The rule provides clarity over which waters are protected under the Clean Water Act. The rule is grounded in law and the latest science, and is shaped by public input. The rule does not create any new permitting requirements and maintains all previous exemptions and exclusions.
