<b>Class II Producer</b>	You must manually enter all data except for Net Production (column I) which is auto-calculated based on entries in columns B through H.	Only the chemical name column is automated, you must manually enter all other data.	N/A	You can return to Section 2 and make changes after completing Section 3 without worrying about losing data already entered (manually and automatically) in Section 3. By pressing the “Proceed to Section 3” button again, any data entered in Section 3 previously will remain intact and all new Section 2 data will be added below current data.
<b>Class II Exporter</b>	You must manually enter all data.	This section is entirely automated.	N/A	Because Section 3 is entirely automated, you can continuously return to Section 2 as needed and change/update values. Pressing the “Proceed to Section 3” button will automatically update Section 3 to reflect any changes made to Section 2.
<b>Class II Importer</b>	You must manually enter all data.	The chemical list (Column A), Gross Imports (Column B), HCFC-141b Exemption (Column G), Total Used Imports (Column I) and Total Heels (Column J) are auto-calculated based on entries in Section 2. You must enter values in columns C-F. Net Imports (Column H) are automatically calculated based on values in Columns B-G.	Only the chemical name is auto-populated; you must manually enter all other values.	You can go back to add more entries in Section 2 after having already filled out Section 3, however, all data previously entered (manually and automatically) in Section 3 will be lost by pressing the “Proceed to Section 3” button. A pop-up will remind you of this if you press “Proceed to Section 3.” You can go between Sections 3 and 4 as often as you like; any values entered manually into Section 4 <i>will not</i> be erased if the “Proceed to Section 3” or “Proceed to Section 4” buttons are pressed.
<b>Class II Request for Additional Consumption Allowances</b>	You must manually enter all data.	This section is entirely automated.	N/A	Because Section 3 is entirely automated, you can continuously return to Section 2 as needed and change/update values. Pressing the “Proceed to Section 3” button will automatically update Section 3 to reflect any changes made to Section 2.

<b>Class I Producer</b>	You must manually enter all data, <i>except</i> for Gross Production (column H) which is automatically calculated based on entries in columns B through G.	N/A	N/A	You can return to Section 2 and make changes after completing Section 3 without worrying about losing data already entered (manually and automatically) in Section 3. By pressing the “Proceed to Section 3” button again, any data entered in Section 3 previously will remain intact and all new Section 2 data will be added below current data.
<b>Class I Exporter</b>	You must manually enter all data.	This section is entirely automated.	N/A	Because Section 3 is entirely automated, you can continuously return to Section 2 as needed and change/update values. The “Proceed to Section 3” program will automatically update Section 3 to reflect any changes made to Section 2.
<b>Class I Importer</b>	You must manually enter all data.	Several columns autopopulate: the chemical list (Column A) autopopulates based on entries in Section 2; Column H autopopulates based on values reported in Columns B through G of Section 3. Columns I and J auto populate based on values reported in Section 2.	N/A	You can return to Section 2 after completing Section 3 without worrying about losing data already entered in Section 3. By pressing the “Proceed to Section 3” button, any changes made to Section 2 since Section 3 was last updated will remain intact and all new data will be added below current data.
