CHP Partnership

- The EPA CHP Partnership (CHPP) is a **voluntary program** that seeks to reduce the environmental impact of power generation by promoting the use of **highly efficient CHP**.
- Through 2012, **the CHPP and its over 470 Partners** put into operation 770 CHP projects representing more than 5,700 MW of capacity.
- The CHPP offers **tools and resources** to assist with CHP project development and overcoming regulatory and other barriers.
