DISCUSSION NOTES

1. Draft “Why Participate” handout discussion

There are actually two draft handouts being prepared. One is a lengthier description of a small, 3x5” version with simple headline bullets describing why one would choose to participate in the removal program.

2. Draft Removal History wording and graphics review and input

The document is intended to provide a narrative as well as a graphic explanation in describing the removal action history and its evolution to now.

Removal action can be broken into three major categories: (1) cleaned up, (2) nothing present, and (3) put into a “holding pattern” to be dealt with later (which is now). The underlying message is that all clean-up actions, throughout the history at the site meet the protective standards.

Document will be co-hosted by EPA, ARP and MDEQ.

3. Planning for June 30th (now mid-July) public meeting (logistics, comment analysis, presentation, process)

A public involvement meeting was originally planned for June 30th, with the comment period to end July 8th. Discussions during the May meeting week revealed the value of extending the comment period through August 7th, with the public meeting now being planned during the week of July 13th.

In lieu of the originally scheduled public meeting, ARP used June 30th to host a public availability session to receive any public comment on the proposed plan and long term management tools.

ARP is currently in process of gathering input on the IC worksheet. They anticipate being able to work with all interested groups and individuals by early July. It is currently planned to have a mid-course content analysis summary of input to the IC worksheet as a part of the presentation at the public meeting in July.
