The Office of Inspector General (OIG) for the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) plans to begin preliminary research to follow up on significant information technology (IT) security findings and recommendations issued in its final reports between fiscal years 2010 through 2012, and reports associated with the fiscal year 2013 OIG key management challenges memorandum issued on July 1, 2013. This project is included in our annual audit plan. The OIG's objective is to determine whether the EPA has implemented corrective actions to address significant IT security findings and recommendations. The project will be conducted using applicable generally accepted government auditing standards. To complete our work as expeditiously as possible and with minimal disruption of your staff, we ask that by January 24, 2014, you email the Project Manager a copy of the agency's last two evaluations of whether the audit follow-up system results in efficient, prompt, and proper resolution and corrective action on audit recommendations [per Office of Management and Budget Circular A-50 Revised, Section 8.a (11)].
