The Office of Inspector General is starting preliminary research on the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency's Fleet Management program. Our objective is to determine whether EPA manages the fleet program in accordance with the federal fleet requirements for operations, acquisitions, utilization, and fuel energy conservation.

During our preliminary research, we plan to interview appropriate personnel and obtain information about the fleet size, fleet utilization, and use of alternative fuels. We will conduct this project using applicable generally accepted government auditing standards. In order for us to complete our work as expeditiously as possible and with minimal disruption of your staff, we request that you provide the information in the attachment, in electronic format, as soon as it is available prior to the kickoff meeting.

We will contact your audit liaison to arrange a mutually agreeable time for a kickoff meeting to discuss the project. At the meeting, we will answer any questions that you may have about this project, the audit process, reporting procedures, methods used to gather and analyze data, and what you should expect during the course of the audit. We are particularly interested in any areas of concern that you may have.

Please provide the following information, electronically, as soon as it is available, prior to our meeting:

- 1. A list of all of the EPA's fleet by location that includes the following for each vehicle in the fleet:
  - Make and model.
  - VIN number (or any other number used for tracking fleet).
  - Classification as EPA-owned, GSA-leased, or commercial—leased.
  - Fuel type usage.
- 2. A list of the EPA's local and regional office and program fleet managers.
- 3. The utilization records for vehicles from December 1, 2012, through May 31, 2013, or provide read-only and report-generating access to the EPA's database of fleet vehicles (Automotive Statistical Tool), so that we can electronically review information on the EPA's fleet records.
