The purpose of this memorandum is to notify you that the EPA Office of Inspector General is beginning a review of Region 6's enforcement actions against Range Resources. This project is being conducted as a result of a congressional request.

Our objective is to determine whether Region 6's issuance of an emergency order under Section 1431 of the Safe Drinking Water Act and the region's subsequent enforcement actions conformed to Agency guidelines, regulations, and policy. We will review the region's interactions with the Texas Railroad Commission, other stakeholders, and the withdrawal of the emergency order. We plan to speak with Region 6 and Office of Enforcement and Compliance Assurance (OECA) management and staff.

Within a week, we will contact you to arrange a mutually agreeable time to discuss our objectives. We will answer any questions you may have about the project process, reporting procedures, methods used to gather and analyze data, and what we should expect of each other during the course of the project.
