The EPA Office of Inspector General (OIG) is beginning the field work phase of our audit of the STAR (Science to Achieve Results) grant program. The EPA OIG's field work objectives are as follows:

- 1. Is EPA effectively monitoring STAR grant recipients' activities?
- 2. Does EPA verify that STAR grant recipients take action to ensure that research misconduct is not associated with grant activities?

The OIG plans to conduct work at EPA headquarters. We would like to schedule an entrance conference the week of December 3, 2012. At the meeting, we will discuss the results of our preliminary research and the additional work we will perform. The audit team will contact the Office of Research and Development audit liaison to schedule the meeting.

During field work, we will be contacting the grant recipients we reviewed during preliminary research to discuss the monitoring of grants, grant terms and conditions, and research misconduct. We will also be requesting a few recipients to provide us the documentation to support a sample of drawdowns. We would appreciate continued cooperation from EPA in providing access to staff for interviews and document collection, and timely responses to information and data requests.

We will regularly update the program office on the status of the audit during field work, which we anticipate will end in April 2013. During this project, the OIG plans to produce the following products by the dates specified:
