The EPA Office of Inspector General (OIG) is starting preliminary research on EPA's Wetlands Program under the Clean Water Act Section 404. This project is included in our FY 2013 annual plan.

The purpose of this memorandum is to schedule a kickoff meeting to confirm our mutual understandings on the objective and scope of the evaluation and the responsibilities of the Office of Water and the EPA OIG during the project.

The OIG's objective is to determine how EPA verifies that the application of its wetlands restoration and protection guidelines achieves the agency's strategic goal of a no net loss of wetlands. We will analyze the efficiency and effectiveness of the agency's oversight of avoidance, minimization and mitigation activities. We plan to perform work within the Office of Water and EPA regions. We may also perform work with States and the US Army Corps of Engineers. The project will be conducted using applicable *Generally Accepted Government Auditing Standards*. The anticipated benefits of this project are improved program integrity and effectiveness through ensuring that the Office of Water is adequately protecting the nation's wetlands.

The project will be supervised by Dan Engelberg, Director of Water and Enforcement Issues and Tim Roach, Project Manager. In addition, we will provide updates on a regular basis through monthly meetings and correspondence with members of your office.
