**Underground Injection Control (UIC) Program
Notice of Final Permit for EXCO Resources, LLC**

The United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) Region III, announced on October 15, 2015, the issuance of a final permit under the authority of the federal UIC regulations at 40 C.F.R. Parts 124, 144, 145, 146 and 147 to EXCO Resources, LLC of Cranberry Township, Pennsylvania. This permit authorizes the continued operation of a UIC Class II-D brine disposal injection well, the Irvin #19-A, located in Bell Township, Clearfield County, Pennsylvania.

EPA Region III previously issued a draft permit for this well on May 27, 2015, and offered to hold a public hearing on the draft permit at the Mahaffey Volunteer Fire Hall in Mahaffey, PA. The public did not respond to the proposal for a public hearing. The Region also requested the receipt of written comments on the draft permit during a specified comment period. EPA's response to comments received has been issued in a separate document.

EPA Region III is announcing the final permit issuance for UIC permit PAS2D205BCLE which will be effective on **October 19, 2015**. The final permit is available for review at the following EPA Region III website:
