### **FUNDING ALLOCATION**

The State of [State Name] understands that based on the allocation formula outlined in the Energy Policy Act of 2005, Subtitle G, Section 793, Fiscal Year 2011 base funds will be 0.47% of the 20% of the Congressional Appropriation and can average approximately \$45,000 per State. Awards may be higher or lower depending on the number of States participating (notification of the final amount is expected to occur by **Monday, May 23, 2011**). States electing to match the entire base EPA State Clean Diesel Program funds will be awarded an additional amount of approximately \$22,500. If there are fewer than 53 participating organizations, then each participating state would receive more than the estimated \$45,000 base funding amount, increasing the match amount required to receive the bonus funds.

Note: The source of match provided by the State will need to be approved by EPA.

## APPLICATION AND WORKPLAN
