Enclosed is a copy of the Central Texas Clean Air Coalition's (CAC's) Ozone Advance Program Action Plan for the Austin-Round Rock Metropolitan Statistical Area (MSA). In its May 16, 2012, sign-up letter for Ozone Advance, the CAC indicated that the existing air quality plan for the region – the 8-O3 Flex – would remain in place until it expired on December 31, 2013, at which time a new plan would be in place. This plan is intended to fulfill that commitment, and will constitute the “path forward” for the region under the Ozone Advance Program through December 31, 2018.

This plan has been developed in accordance with EPA's guidance for the Ozone Advance Program, including extensive community and stakeholder input. Our region's EPA Region 6 staff liaison has reviewed earlier drafts of this plan and provided feedback, which has been addressed in this submission. As you will see in the text of this Action Plan, the CAC intends to update this plan regularly, and will provide you copies of plan updates once approved.
