



Top 10 Federal Government Partner List (as of July 1, 2014)



The Top 10 Federal Government Partner List represents the largest green power users among federal government organizations within the Green Power Partnership. The combined green power usage of these organizations amounts to nearly 1.7 billion kilowatt-hours of green power annually, which is equivalent to avoiding the carbon dioxide emissions from the electricity use of nearly 160,000 average American homes each year.
