INVISTA S.á r.l.'s, Waynesboro, VA facility is submitting this notification that it has commenced operation of the two package boilers as identified in condition 1, equipment reference "Boiler 4" and "Boiler 5" in Stationary Source Permit to Modify and Operate signed by the Virginia Department of Environmental Quality on November 16, 2012.

According to condition 36.b. of the permit, INVISTA is required to furnish written confirmation to the DEQ of the actual start-up date of each of the two boilers (Ref. Boiler 4 and Boiler 5) within 15 days after such date.

The official start-up date for Boiler 5 was January 14, 2014. The official start-up date of Boiler 4 was January 21, 2014.

According to condition 28 of the permit, INVISTA may continue to operate one of the existing boilers (Ref. 2-205 (B#1, B#2 or B#3)) during startup and shakedown of the new boilers (Ref. Boiler 4 or Boiler 5), not to exceed 120 days following startup of any boiler (Ref. Boiler 4 or Boiler 5). INVISTA submitted a mutual shutdown request for B#1 and B#2 which is effective January 9, 2014. INVISTA will submit a mutual shutdown request for B#3 before the 120-day shakedown period ends on May 14, 2014 to document that all three of the existing boilers no longer may operate.
