

## **EPA Region 8 Congressional Affairs and Intergovernmental Relations Intern**

EPA Region 8's Office of Congressional Affairs and Intergovernmental Relations (R8 OCIR) serves as Region 8's principal point of contact with Congress, states and local governments. The Office is responsible for managing all interaction with congressional members and other elected officials, for tracking state and national environmental legislation, for informing Regional and HQ management of congressional and legislative activity, and for ensuring congressional and intergovernmental partners are aware of EPA's activities and announcements.

R8 OCIR is looking for an intern for approximately 120 hours (3 months) to develop profiles of elected officials (congressional members, governors, mayors, etc) within Region 8. These profiles are used for meetings with elected officials to inform EPA about the official's environmental and regulatory areas of concern and/or support, in order to better prepare for such meetings. Information in the profiles will be obtained through on-line directories, on-line research, and letters sent to EPA.
