This program is made possible through a US EPA Targeted Air Shed Grant. This incentive program is part of the SCAQMD's Clean Communities Plan.

To help reduce air pollution and encourage use of electric vehicles, the SCAQMD is implementing a rebate program for installation of plug-in electric vehicle (PEV) infrastructure. The program will help address the growing need for charging infrastructure as plug-in electric hybrid and battery electric vehicle ownership is expanding.

- **Who is Eligible for the Rebate:**

Government agencies and non-profit organizations located in Western Riverside County\*, the City of San Bernardino\*, and Boyle Heights\* that are installing PEV infrastructure after March 4, 2016.

- **What is Covered in the Rebate:**

Equipment costs, including charging stations and solar panels, and installation costs, including electrical upgrades and construction.

- **What is the Amount of the Rebate:**

- Up to \$7,500 per charger.
- Additional \$5,000 for solar panels associated with the PEVs.
- Grant funds are limited to no more than \$42,500 per site.

# Residential EV Charging Incentive Pilot Program



## Program Details

The South Coast Air Quality Management District (SCAQMD) with support from the MSRC (Mobile Source Air Pollution Reduction Review Committee) has established a residential Electric Vehicle (EV) charging incentive pilot program to offset Level 2 (240v) EV supply equipment hardware costs. This program is available to residents within the SCAQMD's four-county jurisdiction.

The program provides an incentive to buy-down the cost of residential chargers, which typically ranges from \$400-\$800. The program will be implemented on a first come, first served basis and will provide up to \$250 for the cost of hardware for Level 2 residential chargers. An additional incentive of up to \$250 will be available for low-income residents.
