

# Water Shortage Response Plan and Cooperative Agreements


...to be able to become strong, healthy, or successful again after something bad happens.

- Know when they need to be replaced


Asset Inventory and Asset Management Plan



## **Asset Management Plan**



### **Current State of Assets**

- Prioritize replacements by year & add cost
- Determine reserve account funding levels

# Capital Improvement Plan and Management Policies



...to be able to become strong, healthy, or successful again after something bad happens.

- Determine multi-year expenses and income and track actual amounts
- Set utility rates that fund adopted planning and policies

# Utility Budget / Updates and Rate Setting



## Resiliency is created

- Emergency Response Plan and VA immediate action
- Water Shortage Response Plan and Cooperative Agreements - pre-event planning
- Asset Management Plan inform capital decisions
- Capital Improvement Plan and Policies formally support budget
- Budget and Rates complete upfront planning

## Resiliency and Financial Viability

- This planning process creates a resilient and financially viable utility
- "Sufficient funds to operate, maintain and manage a public water system, on a continuing basis, in full compliance of federal and state laws" Washington State Department of Health
- This continuous exercise demonstrates to potential funders you are planning for the future and have "stewardship" of your utilities
