## **Air Monitoring Summary**

## Camp Minden North Start Time: 06-16-2016 1800 - End Time: 06-17-2016 1800

June 17, 2016 – EPA monitored for seven ambient air pollutants over a 24 hour period at the Camp Minden North air monitoring location. The seven pollutants included carbon monoxide, carbon dioxide, nitrogen oxide, nitrogen dioxide, nitrogen oxide, and fine particulates. Over the 24 hour period, each of these pollutants were detected below EPA's National Ambient Air Quality Standards or the action benchmark when an air quality standard had not been previously established.

Below is a summary of Camp Minden Air Monitoring Data collected at the location referenced above. The table contains a detailed listing of the following:

- 1 Average reading of each analyte from June 16, 2016 1800 through June 17, 2016, 2016 1800
- 2 Highest measurement of each analyte from June 16, 2016 1800 through June 17, 2016 1800

National Ambient Air Quality Standards (NAAQS) of criteria pollutants (CO, NO2, SO2, and PM2.5) are listed with specific time frames and calculation formulas. \*\* Note: The NOx and CO analyzers were operating normally. The SO2 analyzer continued zero air purging. The CO2 purge was restored and the analyzer calibrated in the morning on 6/17. The analyzer was placed back online after that time. The SO2 analyzer will continue to undergo zero air purge through the weekend, and instrument flow will be monitored for improvement. Trailer conditions are being monitored during night shift to confirm effectiveness of steps to prevent condensation.

\*\* Note: PM2.5 was captured in 60-min averages. All other analytes were captured in 1-min averages.
