The United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) and the United States Coast Guard (USCG) are hosting a compliance assistance workshop for their oil spill prevention, preparedness and response regulations found at 40 CFR 112 and 33 CFR 154.

The workshop will include a review of the oil spill prevention and preparedness regulations, inspection protocols, potential violations, enforcement process and a detailed discussion of what facilities can do to be better prepared for their compliance inspections. A presentation of case studies will share actual observations found during SPCC/FRP inspections and drills. There will also be a discussion of the recently expanded OSRO classification program impacting response resources within the inland zone. The workshop will conclude with a question and answer session.
