The EPA has reviewed the Grenada Manufacturing, LLC (Grenada) PRB Pilot Test Work Plan submitted to the EPA on April 1, 2016. At this time, the EPA has no comments. The work plan is approved, and the scope of work should begin as soon as possible.

The EPA continues to be concerned about contaminant levels in Riverdale Creek due to the ineffectiveness of the PRB. Mississippi Department of Environmental Quality (MDEQ) has posted a non-contact advisory for a portion of the creek adjacent to and downstream of the facility. Therefore, this matter is of high importance to the EPA and MDEQ and should be handled expeditiously. The EPA will evaluate the results of these additional actions to ensure that timely and effective enhancements to the PRB effectiveness are achieved.
