

Subpart J Manufacturer Reminders:

The following reminders are for manufacturers of products that are currently listed on the National Oil and Hazardous Substances Pollution Contingency Plan (NCP) Product Schedule.

Product Disclaimer under Subpart J:

The listing of a product on the NCP Product Schedule does not constitute approval of the product. To avoid possible misinterpretation or misrepresentation, any label, advertisement, website, or technical literature that refers to the placement of the product on the NCP Schedule must either reproduce in its entirety EPA's written statement that it will add the product to the NCP Product Schedule under 40 CFR section 300.920 (a)(2) or (b)(2), or include the disclaimer shown below. When the disclaimer is used, it must be conspicuous and must be fully reproduced. Failure to comply with these restrictions or any other improper attempt to demonstrate the approval of the product by any NRT or other U.S. Government agency shall constitute grounds for removing the product from the NCP Product Schedule.

Disclaimer:

[PRODUCT NAME] is on the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency's NCP Product Schedule. This listing does NOT mean that EPA approves, recommends, licenses, certifies, or authorizes the use of [PRODUCT NAME] on an oil discharge. This listing means only that data have been submitted to EPA as required by Subpart J of the National Contingency Plan, 40 CFR Section 300.915.

EPA LOGO:

EPA does not endorse or approve products. Use of the EPA Logo on any NCP product advertising information is never permitted. *All EPA logos must be removed from all product websites*, *advertising and labeling or any other documents*. Failure to remove the EPA logo constitutes removal of a product from the NCP Product Schedule.

Making Changes to Product Schedule Contact Information:

Please notify EPA of any changes to your contact information. It is critical that we have updated information in case it is needed during a spill. For your protection, when providing updates in contact information, EPA will request verification information for significant changes. Hard copies of Confidential Business Information (CBI) may be requested as verification. Manufacturers should have a copy of their product's CBI on file and the information should mirror what EPA has on file for your product.

EPA or EPA contractors will NEVER ask for CBI over the phone or over the Internet.
