ACTIVITY: The main discharge consists of excess spring water and water from miscellaneous seeps that come out of the stone walls at various places and flow onto the floor. Sanitary wastewater, cooling tower blowdown, etc., are routed to the sanitary sewer system at Fort Carson. There are also potential discharges from two exhaust stacks. All discharges would go to unnamed ephemeral tributaries to Fountain Creek. The CMAFS is located on the slopes of Cheyenne Mountain on the southwest edge of the City of Colorado Springs at approximate latitude 38.744722° N and longitude 104.843333° W. Authorization for discharge is limited to only those outfalls specifically listed in the permit.

PUBLIC COMMENTS: Comment period ends 30 calendar days after the date of publication of this notice. Comments must be directed to: Robert Shankland (8WP-CWW), U.S. Environmental Protection Agency, Region 8, 1595 Wynkoop Street, Denver, CO 80202-1129. All comments received prior to the end of the comment period will be considered in the formulation of any final permit determination, and will be part of the administrative record. Any commenter may request a public hearing and the EPA will hold a hearing if the response to this notice indicates significant public interest. The EPA is also requesting comments on the possible adverse effects of reissuing the permit on historic properties and/or cultural resources in the area.
