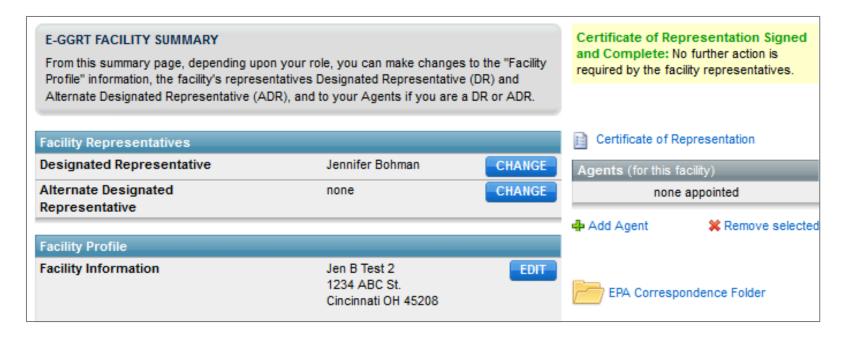


Reminders – Update DR, ADR, and Agents

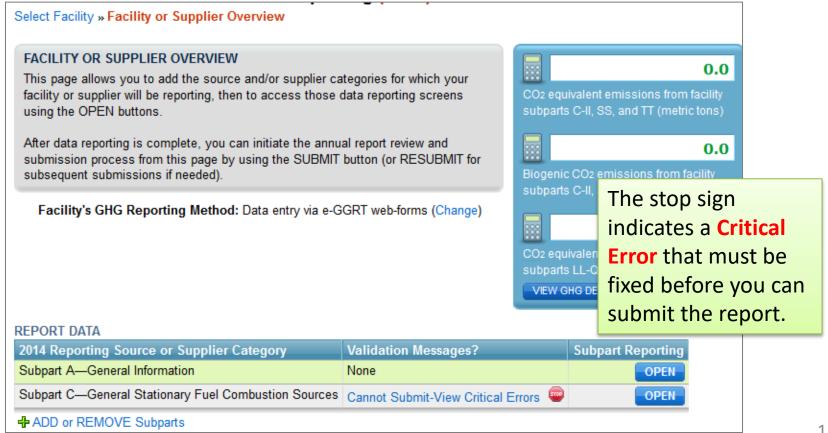
- XML Schema has changed since last year

 - Version v7.1 must be used for all RY2016, RY2015,
 RY2014, RY2013, RY2012, or RY2011 reporting.

Reminders - Critical Errors

EPA has designated many data quality checks as "Critical Errors." You can see if your report has Critical Errors on the Facility or Supplier Overview page. Allow adequate time to correct these errors prior to submission.

Revisions to the GHG Reporting Rule; Final Rule

- Final rule published on December 9, 2016
 - 81 FR 89188
 - https://www.epa.gov/ghgreporting/rulemaking-notices-ghgreporting
- Covered revisions to 30 subparts to:
 - Streamline implementation and reduce burden
 - Improve data quality; provide useful data for GHG Inventory
 - Better reflect industry processes and emissions
 - Improve rule understanding via clarifications and corrections
- Phase in implementation over 3 years
 - January 1, 2017 January 1, 2019
 - Effective dates specified in the FR notice

Revisions effective January 1, 2017

- Subpart A General Provisions
 - Clarify opportunities to stop reporting
 - If all covered processes cease to operate or facility no longer meets "Definition of Source Category" in a subpart
 - Underground coal mines can stop reporting if abandoned and sealed
 - Clarify the need to resubmit a report in which there were substantive errors only within the time period required to maintain records
 - 3 or 5 years depending on whether facility uses iVT
- Subpart I Electronics Manufacturing
 - Revisions to Equation I-24
 - Additions/clarifications to Triennial Technology Report (1st one submitted with RY2016 reports)
 - Edits to Tables I-3 and I-4 (to fix typos)

Revisions effective January 1, 2017

Subpart FF – Underground Coal Mines

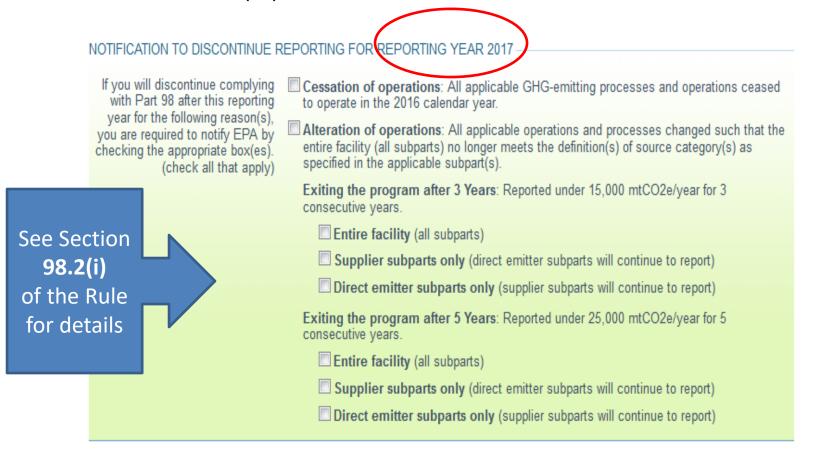
- Incorporates the latest version of the MSHA Handbook (Handbook Number PH16-V-1) for use when taking samples and measurements.
- Applies to measurements taken during Calendar Year 2017, (affecting data in RY2017 reports which are submitted to EPA in March of 2018).

Subpart HH – MSW Landfills

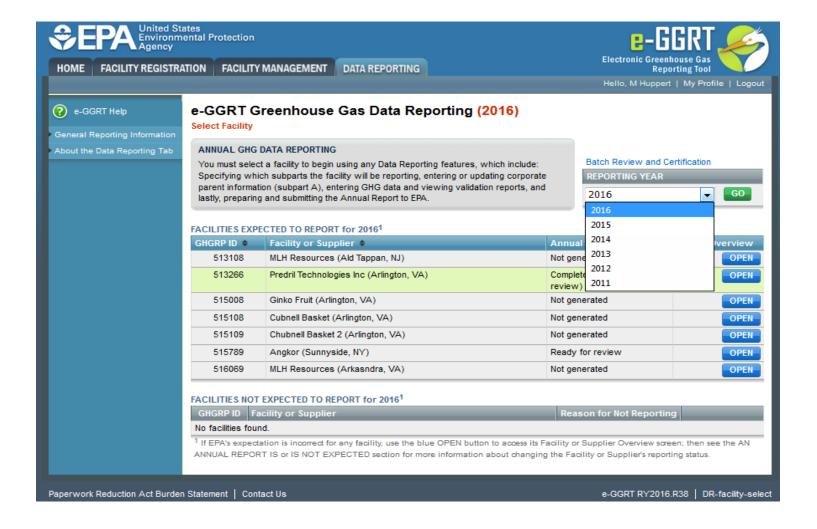
- Removed requirement to report surface area by cover type
 - Still need to report cover types and total surface area
- Removed 24-inch soil cover requirement for using higher oxidation fractions, instead require at least intermediate or interim soil cover (Table HH-4)
- Added definitions of final cover, intermediate or interim cover, and passive vent for clarity

How Do I Notify EPA That I Will Discontinue Reporting?

If 2016 will be your last submission: At the bottom of the Facility Overview page, select the correct box(es) and click **SAVE**.

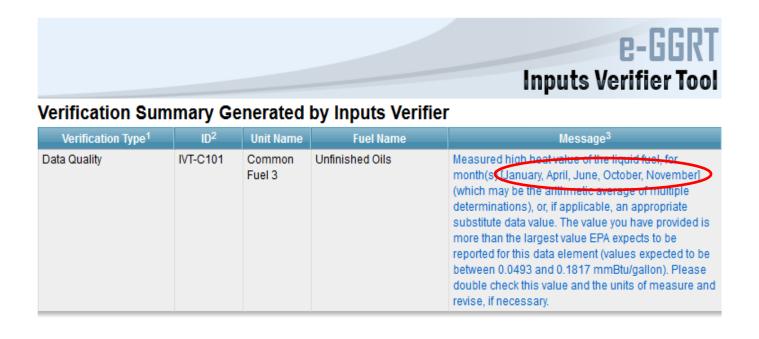


New Feature-Sunsetting of RY2010



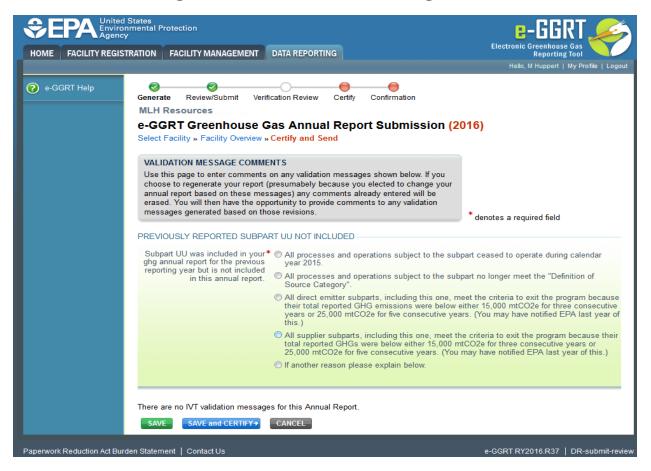
New Feature Validation- Consolidated Validation Message

One improvement in our validation process this year is consolidation of validation messages. Where in prior years you would see repeating messages for each month or quarter that suffered a particular data quality issue. We've consolidated those repetitious messages where possible as shown below:

New Feature- Subpart I Triennial Technology Assessment Report Upload

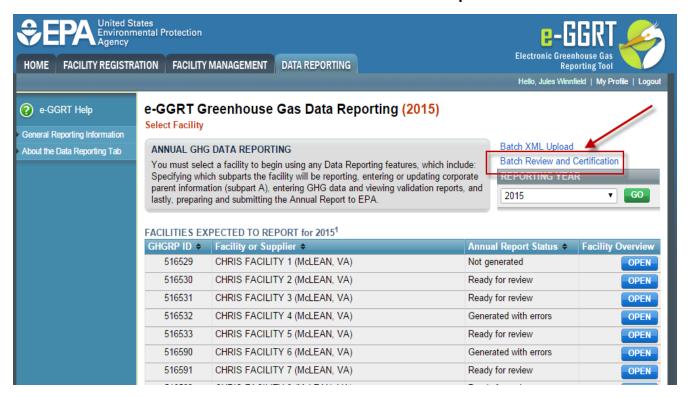

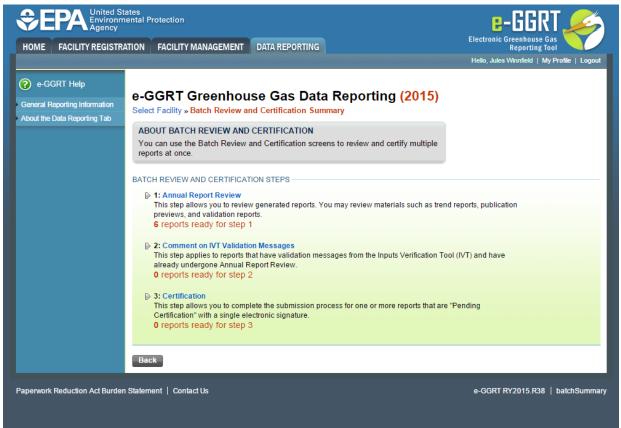
What is the batch review & certification module?

Many e-GGRT users certify and submit reports for multiple facilities. The **BATCH REVIEW AND CERTIFICAION** link will only appear for any user with 3 or more facilities. Following data entry and report generation, you have the option to use this new module to streamline report submission.



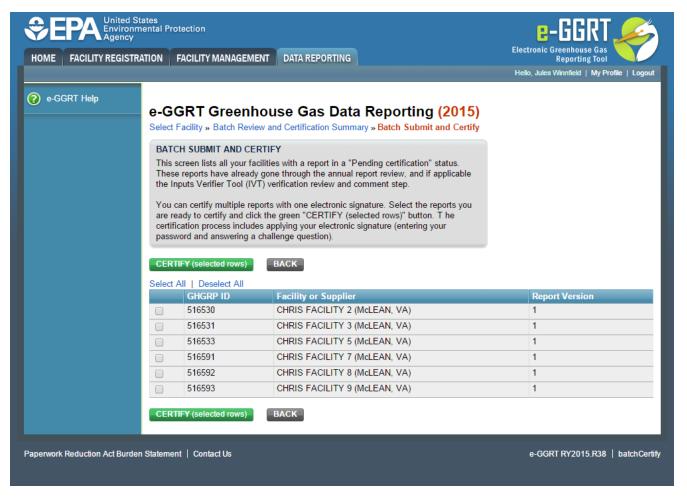
What is the batch review & certification module? (Continued)

The module contains the same steps and information as the standard submission module. However, it compiles the information in one place so that you can move through the process more quickly. Each report will need to proceed through each of these 3 steps.



What is the batch review & certification module? (Continued)

Step 3: Certification. Check the boxes for the facilities where you are ready to certify the report. Then, click the green "CERTIFY" button.
