Dear Sir or Madam:

I am writing to inform you that the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency is withdrawing its request that you provide the agency information on your oil and natural gas facilities under section 114 of the Clean Air Act. The withdrawal was effective upon announcement on March 2, 2017, meaning that you are no longer required to provide information or data as specified in the letter dated November 14, 2016, that the EPA sent you last year.

The EPA is withdrawing the information request because the Administrator would like to assess the need for the information that the agency was collecting through these requests. This withdrawal applies to both Part 1 (operator survey) and Part 2 (facility survey) of the November 2016 information request. You are no longer required to provide information for either survey, even if you received an extension to your original due date for information.

If you have already completed your survey and provided it to the EPA, I thank you. You do not need to do anything else related to this information request. The EPA will preserve the data it has received as required by the Federal Records Act and other applicable laws, regulations and guidance, as well as laws and regulations regarding confidential business information.
