I have reviewed the document, and found two places where ORIA edits were not incorporated by OFR. These are described below.

Page 95, last sentence above the deleted definition:

OFR version: "...definitions at 40 CFR 61.251 to remove the reference to "new" tailings..."

**ORIA edit:** "...definitions at 40 CFR 61.251 to replace<del>remove</del> the reference to "new" tailings with the broader term "uranium byproduct material or tailings"..." (the trailing comma can be retained at OFR discretion)

**Explanation:** more precise indication of the change addresses removal of reg text.

Page 105, first full paragraph reformatted by OFR:

**ORIA edit:** Text following "40 CFR part 192:" in the third sentence should be in quotation marks (i.e., should read "Even if a portion...as defined by 40 CFR 192.31(q)" before the FR citation).

**Explanation:** This single paragraph was originally an introductory paragraph ending with "40 CFR part 192:" that was followed by an off-set FR citation. In creating the clean version of the document, it appears these two separate pieces became combined as one off-set paragraph. The simplest solution is to retain the quoted material within the paragraph, but add the quotation marks.

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**Explanation:** more precise indication of the change addresses removal of reg text.

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**Explanation:** This single paragraph was originally an introductory paragraph ending with "40 CFR part 192:" that was followed by an off-set FR citation. In creating the clean version of the document, it appears these two separate pieces became combined as one off-set paragraph. The simplest solution is to retain the quoted material within the paragraph, but add the quotation marks.

I note two edits that were not highlighted by OFR. On page 105, a paragraph was re-formatted by OFR. This formatting issue seems to have resulted when a set-off quote became combined with the preceding paragraph (probably when creating the final clean version), so that the entire paragraph was indented. I have revised this to keep the quote within the paragraph.

In the regulatory text, section 61.255(c)(1) refers to the CDX website (page 142). I have updated this

reference. This change was requested from OP along with a similar change to footnote 19 (page 83), by hand-marking the printed version submitted to the OFR. The change was made in footnote 19, but not in the regulatory text.
