This letter acknowledges receipt of the Primacy Revision Application dated
December 13, 2016, submitted by Mr. Andrew Hammond, Acting Director, of the Office of Drinking
Water. This package modifies Virginia's Public Water System Supervision Program for the adoption of
the Revised Total Coliform Rule (RTCR). Virginia is commended for its efforts to adopt this rule.

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has determined that Virginia's Primacy Revision Application is complete and final. Interim primacy is granted pursuant to 40 C.F.R. §142.12(e) and remains in effect until EPA approves or disapproves the revised primacy program. EPA's ninety (90) day review period, per 40 C.F.R. §142.12(d)(3), begins on the date of this letter. We will notify you of our decision.
