In recognition of the United States Army's efforts to investigate and, where necessary, remediate Finding of Suitability to Transfer (FOST) Areas I - IV (the "Property"), the Arkansas Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ) and the United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) Region 6 together have determined that the Property is Ready for Reuse.
