

Gasoline Sulfur Facility Summary Report (Report Form ID: GSF0302): Instructions for Completing

Who must report

• Each facility producing or importing gasoline during the annual averaging period must submit this report.

Reporting deadlines

• Submitted to EPA no later than March 31 each year for the prior calendar year.
