

New River Solid Waste Association issues RFP for Landfill Gas-to-Energy Project



As a service to our Partners and stakeholders, EPA's Landfill Methane Outreach Program (LMOP) is pleased to share information about a Request for Proposals (RFP) issued by the New River Solid Waste Association (NRSWA) in Raiford, Florida. Please note, EPA is not affiliated or associated in any way with the RFP, including the selection process.

NRSWA issued RFP #18-01 for developing a landfill gas to compressed natural gas (LFG-to-CNG) project at the New River Regional Landfill (NRRL), an active municipal solid waste landfill in Union County, Florida. The Vendor shall be qualified to convert landfill gas to CNG and the selected Vendor will be required to assume full responsibility for all services offered in their proposal.

A pre-proposal meeting and site tour will be held on Wednesday, March 28, 2018, at 10:00 a.m. (Eastern Time) at the NRRL, which is located 2.5 miles north of Raiford, Florida on State Road 121 in Union County, Florida. Attendance is strongly encouraged, but not mandatory.
