**PROJECT DESCRIPTION**: The Accelerated Gravity Sewer Assessment and Rehabilitation project will rehabilitate 65 wastewater pumping station basins including over 900,000 feet of gravity mains. Projects included in the scope have a high consequence of failure. The purpose of the project is to prevent an increasing number of emergency sewer failures and reduce inflow and infiltration into the gravity sewer system. These improvements will effectively increase treatment capacity available for growth without facility expansion.

Selected borrowers must apply for a WIFIA loan, pass a final creditworthiness assessment, negotiate a mutually agreeable term sheet, and execute a credit agreement to receive WIFIA financing. An invitation to apply indicates that EPA believes the selected projects will be able to attain WIFIA loans.
