Dear Mr. Juris:

Thank you for your request for correction under the Environmental Protection Agency's Information Quality Guidelines dated October 21, 2002. Your request was received in this office on October 23, 2002. Following a thorough review, we believe this request does not fall under the Information Quality Guidelines because your request only recommends the EPA alter the format of documents EPA 453/R-96-007 and EPA 453/R-97-004 provided on the web, rather than requesting correction of information under the Guidelines. Because the correction process under the Guidelines is limited to requests for correction of information disseminated by EPA, the Guidelines correction process does not apply to your request.

Although the issues in your request regarding these documents are not covered by the Information Quality Guidelines, EPA has now created PDF versions of these electronic files and posted them on EPA's website. Please note that because your request is not covered by the Guidelines, the Guidelines reconsideration process does not apply.
