The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) received your petition, dated February 23, 2006, regarding the Part 70 Operating Permit for the CITGO Refining and Chemical Company, West Plant. Under Texas' approved Title V Operating Permit Program at 30 Texas Administrative Code 122.350(b)(3), EPA's 45-day review period will not begin until receipt of comments and the general operating permit with any revisions following the public hearing. Any person may petition the Administrator within 60 days after the expiration of EPA's 45-day review period. Because EPA's review period has not yet begun, EPA deems your petition received on February 23, 2006, to be untimely, pursuant to § 505(b)(2) of the Clean Air Act and 40 Code of Federal Regulations § 70.8(d).
