EPA's Landfill Methane Outreach Program (LMOP) is pleased to **recognize the 95 LMOP Partners who participated in the program's voluntary data collection in 2018**. Information about these Partners and the data collection are highlighted in a [recognition file on the LMOP website](#). Collectively, these Partners reviewed and verified data for a **total of 390 landfill gas (LFG) energy projects and 58 landfills**. The updates provided for these records are reflected in the [Excel files of data](#) on the LMOP website.

As part of joining LMOP, select Partners agree to annually provide information about their landfills and LFG energy projects which LMOP uses to update the program's Landfill and LFG Energy Project Database (LMOP Database). Through their participation, **Partners help improve the quality and completeness of the LMOP Database**, a key resource for EPA, the LFG industry and the general public.

In 2018, LMOP transitioned to voluntary Partner reporting through a new LMOP module in EPA's existing e-GGRT system. LMOP transitioned to e-GGRT because it was expected to decrease reporting burden and improve efficiencies.
