The Authority is soliciting proposals from qualified companies for the **development of a landfill gas (LFG) energy project** at its **Regional Landfill - Livestock Road Facility (LRF)**. The Authority will consider technically and financially feasible beneficial uses of the LFG, including electricity generation, direct use of medium-Btu LFG, production of renewable natural gas, or other suitable technologies.

The scope of work includes project planning, permitting, financing, design, construction, operation, maintenance and monitoring services, as well as marketing, sale and distribution of the LFG and its attributes.

A mandatory pre-proposal conference will be held at 10:00 AM (ET) on November 14, 2019, at 361 Livestock Road, Rustburg, VA 24588. Proposals are due no later than 4:00 PM (ET) on December 19, 2019.
