- Chapter 7. Best Practices for Landfill Gas Collection System Design and Installation provides information on site-specific factors that influence the design of a gas collection system and discusses a variety of collection component options to help operators minimize surface emissions and system downtime.
- Chapter 8. Best Practices for Landfill Gas Collection System Operation and Maintenance presents information on managing liquids in a gas collection system, wellhead monitoring and health and safety considerations to help operators achieve a safe and functional system.
