(OXY) in accordance with the Section 3008(h) Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA), 42 U.S.C. § 6928(h) Administrative Order on Consent (AOC) (RCRA Docket No: RCRA-05-2020-0006 with an effective date of January 24, 2020) for the Former Cities Refinery at 2500 Rear East Chicago Avenue, East Chicago, Indiana (EPA ID: INR000123927, formerly part of IND095267381) (Site).
