The County is solicting proposals from qualified companies to **develop a renewable energy project using the landfill gas (LFG) collected at the Blackburn Landfill and pay the County for the LFG**. The County will consider proposals for technically and financially feasible beneficial uses, including electricity generation, direct use of medium-Btu LFG, production of renewable natural gas, or other technologies. The County owns and operates the Blackburn Landfill, and also owns and operates an existing LFG electricity project which will be discontinued due to the age of the engine gensets.
