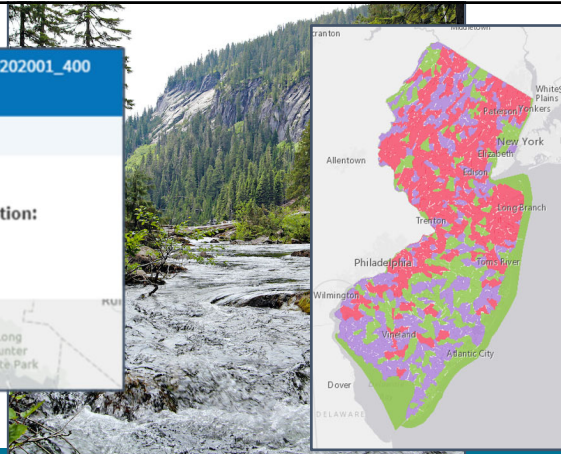

Pulling the Pieces Together: Telling the Water Story

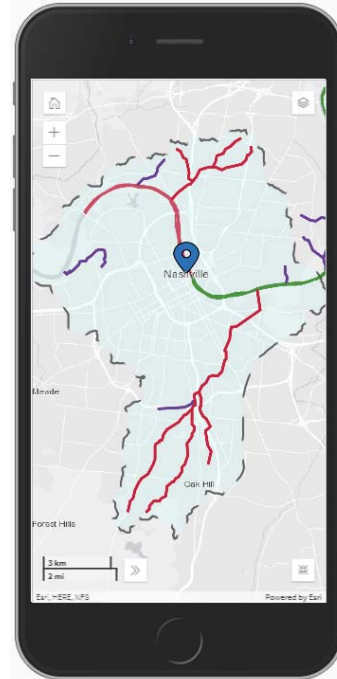
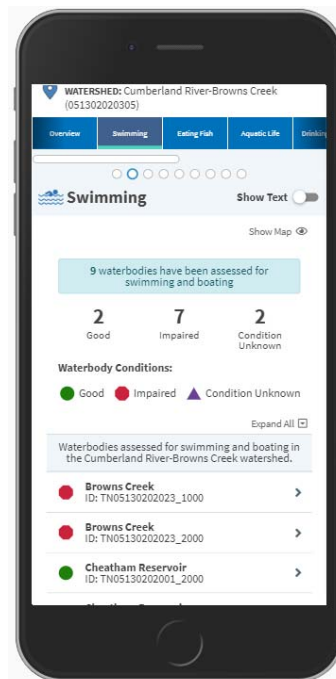
HMW:

- Provides the public with usable, meaningful information.
- Communicates progress states, tribes, and EPA are making towards restoring or protecting water quality.
- Engages the public in understanding impacts on water and issues related to water.



How's My Waterway

- All information is based on a service.
- Tells the story at multiple levels (National, State, Community).
- Integrates data across systems.
- Allows for in-depth stories in addition to interactive content.
