

NW Natural RFP for Renewable Natural Gas



As a service to our Partners and other stakeholders, EPA's Landfill Methane Outreach Program (LMOP) is sharing information about a **request for proposals (RFP) from Northwest Natural Gas Company (NW Natural) to procure renewable natural gas (RNG) supplies**. Please note that EPA is not affiliated in any way with the review and selection process. Information provided below is based on the RFP.

NW Natural provides natural gas distribution services to customers in Oregon and southwestern Washington state. Recent state policies and rules give natural gas utilities in the Pacific Northwest the ability to provide RNG to their customers.

Through this RFP, NW Natural seeks to **determine potential partners in the RNG market who are interested in long-term agreements to sell their RNG**. Bidders can propose to sell and deliver to NW Natural a bundled product consisting of the RNG and its Renewable Thermal Certificates, or to sell and deliver all the Renewable Thermal Certificates of an unbundled RNG product.

The **deadline for questions** about this RFP is **August 10, 2020**, and **proposals are due** by **September 4, 2020**. Please refer to the RFP for complete information about this procurement. Questions and submissions must be sent to renewables@nwnatural.com.
