What community sectors or demographic groups have we not sufficiently engaged... what strategies and activities could be helpful to promote more participation from those sectors? If you work outside the basin, what strategies have worked in your community?
4. What funding or financing strategies might support our work toward creating a river corridor that supports the future economic, social and environmental vitality of our river communities?
