HOW SET-ASIDES WORK

Technical assistance and training are critical to sustaining our drinking water systems. States may use up to approximately 31% of their annual DWSRF grant (called a "set-aside") from EPA to use for these activities. All 50 States + Puerto Rico have DWSRF programs.


