Highlights since the 2010 Five-Year Review

- **Partial Deletion of the surface and subsurface soils from the National Priorities List (NPL) will be made once the new dioxin Regional Screening Levels have been determined.**
- **Remedial System Evaluation has been completed at the site. EPA and DEQ worked with the stakeholders to implement some of the recommendations in 2010. These are discussed in the five-year review report.**
- **A site-wide Ready for Anticipated Reuse determination was made on September 20, 2010.**
