What to expect

A sediment remediation project will take place in the Scanlon Reservoir to protect human health and the environment. This work is being conducted by EPA and the Minnesota Pollution Control Agency through a Great Lakes Legacy Act partnership.

Due to project construction, Scanlon River Park and the St. Louis River Recreational Trail, parking area, and road will be closed to vehicle and pedestrian traffic through the end of 2022.
