The facility is located at 1395 South Lake Street, Farmington, San Juan County, New Mexico. Under the Standard Industrial Classification Code 4952, the applicant operates a municipal wastewater treatment plant (WWTP) with a design capacity of 6.67 million gallons per day serving a population of approximately 50,000. The discharge from the WWTP is to the San Juan River, State of New Mexico Segment No. 20.6.4.401 of the San Juan Basin. Designated uses of the receiving water are stated in the Fact Sheet.

This is a renewal of a permit previously issued on September 30, 2016, with an effective date of November 1, 2016, and an expiration date of October 31, 2021.

Changes from the previous permit are:

- Revised TDS net incremental increase limit and mass loading limit have been established;
- Changed WET monitoring frequency to once/quarter using Daphnia pulex Pimephales promelas;
- Cadmium, 2,3,7,8-TCDD Dioxin, Pentachlorophenol, Aldrin, Chlordane and Toxaphene pollutants monitoring requirements have been added; and,
- Cyanide limits and compliance schedules have been established.

The NPDES permit will not be issued until the certification requirements of Section 401 have been met.
