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

Tackling the Climate Crisis: A Whole-of-Government Approach

- > President Biden issued Executive Order 14008 on *Tackling the Climate Crisis at Home and Abroad*
- > Additional requirements for agencies:
 - ✓ Policy Statement on Climate Change Adaptation
 - ✓ Climate Adaptation Action Plan
- ➤ Major focus: Securing Environmental Justice

"Agencies shall make achieving environmental justice part of their missions by developing programs, policies, and activities to address the disproportionately high and adverse human health, environmental, climate-related and other cumulative impacts on disadvantaged communities, as well as the accompanying economic challenges of such impacts."

EPA's Climate Adaptation Action Plan Released on October 7th!

2021 EPA Policy Statement on Climate Adaptation

Key Directives for all EPA offices

"Integrate climate adaptation planning into EPA programs, policies and rulemaking processes"

"Consult and partner with states, **tribes**, territories, local governments, environmental justice organizations, community groups, businesses, and other federal agencies to strengthen adaptive capacity and increase the resilience of the nation, with a particular focus on advancing environmental justice."

Key Commitment

"The EPA will actively engage with organizations representing overburdened and underserved communities that are more vulnerable to climate impacts to ensure the EPA's adaptation plans reflect the principles of environmental justice and equity."

Signed by Administrator Michael Regan in May 2021 & released with EPA's 2021 Climate Adaptation Action Plan

EPA Climate Adaptation Action Plan Priorities

Integrate climate adaptation into EPA programs, policies, rulemaking processes, and enforcement activities.

Consult and partner with states, tribes, territories, environmental justice organizations, community groups, businesses, and other federal agencies to strengthen adaptive capacity and increase the resilience of the nation, with a particular focus on advancing environmental justice.

Implement measures to protect the agency's workforce, facilities, critical infrastructure, supply chains and procurement processes from the risks posed by climate change.

Measure and evaluate performance.

Identify and address climate adaptation science needs.

Integrate climate adaptation into EPA programs, policies, rulemaking processes, and enforcement activities.

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

Tribal Vulnerabilities identified in EPA Tribal Environmental Plans

In review of all Region 10 ETEPs:

- Every Tribe, Nation, and Confederacy identified at least one climate priority
- The average number of climate adaptation priorities identified in an ETEP has increased from about three (3) to about seven (7) since 2014
- 76% of Tribes, Nations, and Confederacies in WA, OR, and ID specifically identified climate change as a priority
- Top climate adaptation priorities vary between WA/OR/ID and AK



Climate Adaptation Action Plan is aligned with the EPA Strategic Plan

Objective 1.2: Accelerate Resilience and Adaptation to Climate Change Impacts—Deliver targeted assistance to increase the resilience of Tribes, states, territories, and communities to the impacts of climate change.
