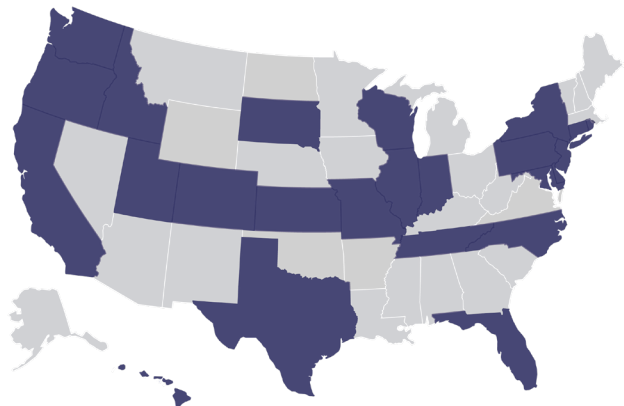

The purpose of these projects is to ensure full compliance with health and safety regulations and protect against future sewer spills to the groundwater and shorelines.
