The total combined volatile organic compound emissions, from Source IDs P101, P103, P104 and P105 at this facility, shall not exceed 85.00 tons in any 12 consecutive month period.

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#### IV. RECORDKEEPING REQUIREMENTS.

The permittee shall keep accurate and comprehensive records of the following:

- (1) The quantity and identity of each bead type used in the expandable polystyrene foam manufacturing facility for each day.
- (2) The volatile organic compound content, based on supplier certificates of analysis, of each bead type used in the expandable polystyrene foam manufacturing facility for each day.
- (3)
- (4) The supporting calculations used to verify compliance with the 12 consecutive month volatile organic compourednission limitation established for Source IDs P101, P103, P104 and P105 at the facility for each month.
- (5) The supporting calculations used to verify compliance with the monthly-weighted average pentane content limitation







established for the polystyrene beads used at this facility for each month.

All records generated pursuant to this condition shall be retained for a minimum of five (5) years and shall be made available to the Department upon request.

#### V. REPORTING REQUIREMENTS.

#### # 014 [25 Pa. Code §127.441]

Operating permit terms and conditions.

The permittee shall submit quarterly reports of the following:

- (1) The supporting calculations used to verify compliance with the 12 consecutive month volatile organic compound emission limitation established for all sources at the facility for each month during the respective calendar quarter.
- (2) The supporting calculations used to verify compliance with the monthly-weighted average pentane content limitation of the polystyrene beads used at this facility for each month during the respective calendar quarter.

The quarterly reports shall be submitted to the Department by no later than June 1 for the preceding January 1 to March 31 time period, September 1 for the preceding April 1 to June 30 time period, November 1 for the preceding July 1 to September 30 time period and March 1 for the preceding October 1 to December 31 time period.

The monthly-weighted average pentane content of the polystyrene beads used at this facility shall not exceed 6.0%.

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
