FY2023 GAP Funding Announcement

Award Information

For Fiscal Year 2023, the Region's funding priorities will be:

- 1) Funding of no greater than \$135,000 for eligible tribal applicants.
- 2) Funding of no greater than \$135,000 for a limited number of eligible consortia.

Application Information

The following procedure is outlined for addressing stand-alone GAP applications not meeting the deadline:

- 1) Office of Communities, Tribes and Environmental Assessment (OCTEA) will contact Tribal leadership and environmental staff by phone or written communication regarding the missed deadline.
- 2) The grantee will be notified that they will be granted a two-week extension for submitting a GAP application. March 3, 2023 will be the new deadline for late GAP proposals to be considered with a budget range of \$75,000 - \$100,000 per year.
- 3) If a GAP application is not received by March 3, 2023, OCTEA will contact the grantee and inform them that they will be considered only for the base funding amount of \$75,000. An additional time extension will be granted for no longer than March 17, 2023 to submit a GAP proposal for the base amount funding.
- 4) Any GAP application submitted after March 17, 2023 may not be considered for GAP funding.
