IV. RECORDKEEPING REQUIREMENTS.

001 [25 Pa. Code §129.99]

Alternative RACT proposal and petition for alternative compliance schedule.

The permittee shall monitor and record solvent usage and VOC emissions for this source on a monthly and 12 month rolling sum basis. These records shall be retained for five (5) years and shall be made available to the Department upon request.

VI. WORK PRACTICE REQUIREMENTS.

Alternative RACT proposal and petition for alternative compliance schedule.

This source shall be operated and maintained in accordance with manufacturers specifications and good operating practices.

Alternative RACT proposal and petition for alternative compliance schedule.

The Permittee shall comply with the following work practice standards for the source in this group:

- (a) Store all VOC-containing materials and used shop towels in closed containers.
- (b) Ensure that mixing and storage containers used for VOC-containing cleaning materials are kept closed at all times except when depositing or removing these materials.
- (c) Minimize spills of VOC-containing cleaning materials and clean up spills immediately.
- (d) Convey VOC-containing cleaning materials from one location to another in closed containers or pipes.
- (e) Minimize VOC emissions from cleaning of storage, mixing and conveying equipment.
- (f) Provide operator training on the above work practice standards.
